TITAN Metal Finishing takes very seriously the EICC (Electronic Industry Citizenship Coalition) Code of Conduct and its standards on social, environmental and ethical issues in the supply chain. It is of the highest priority that we and our suppliers are not endangering the health and wellbeing of others.

We certify that TITAN Metal Finishing, Inc. as well as all other TITAN facilities worldwide meets these requirements. As a global group we do not purchase any materials that are known to come from conflict sources. We audit all of our tantalum suppliers to make sure that they comply and offer their certification that their materials are "conflict free". We will maintain this vigilance to keep up with ever changing global supply to insure that we will always be "conflict free"
